BRIEF FAITH ACTIVITIES TO DO AT HOME.

Online/At Home Scavenger Hunt and Show and Tell Game

Directions:

1 - Create a list of things that your youth can try to find and bring to show on the zoom (don't share this list with the group!). (Make these easy or challenging depending on the age and ability of your group. Be sensitive and aware of different family's privacy and resources - try to avoid making it a "one-upping" competition.)

Our recommendation: make each item something that can be interpreted different by each individual. Ex: your favorite socks, the largest book in your house, the silliest thing you own, your favorite childhood toy, the most delicious thing in your home, the biggest thing you can lift, the fluffiest object in your home, the smelliest object in your home, the newest thing, the oldest thing, etc. As young people may get excited and run through their house - avoid sharp items such as scissors and fragile items, such as glass or lamps)

2 - set up time/date/and platform for the game (you may wish to use Zoom, Facebook live or another online platform where you can see and hear everyone).

3 - when everyone is together online, share the rules:

- The leader will, one-at-a-time, name an item from the list that the group members have to find in their home or nearby.
- Each group member will have 1 minute to grab that item and bring it to the group. (You can even set a timer or start counting down out loud when there are only 10 seconds left to build excitement.)
- Once everyone has returned, have each person share what they found and why they picked it.

Optional - you can create a point system and offer prizes if you would like to make it a competition or instead make it a get-to-know-you game. To increase the intensity, you can change the amount of time each person has to gather their item (only 30 seconds, 2 minutes, etc).
