

Emergency Prayers

There are many opportunities to pray during the day that can pass us by. Enhance your family's prayer life by praying aloud whenever you hear a siren, see an emergency vehicle, or pass someone whose vehicle has broken down.

Summer, while this activity is valuable all year-long you might consider starting it during a summer road trip.

Needed

No items needed, other than prayer (see next page for suggestions)

Activity Plan

- 1. When you hear a siren; see an ambulance, fire truck or police car speeding to the scene of an accident; or see a person whose car has broken down on the side of the road (and it is not prudent to stop); pray aloud for those who are in pain or danger, as well as for those responding to the emergency, including firefighters, police personnel, EMTs, and paramedics.
- Consider a prayer familiar to the family that can be prayed together such as The Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, or Glory Be; or a spontaneous prayer requesting protection, guidance, wisdom, peace and comfort for all involved. Also consider praying a Prayer for Emergency Responders (see next page).
- 3. This habit may inspire children (as well as adults) to offer up spur-of-the-moment prayers more frequently during the day—prompted by sights and sounds—when it may not have occurred to them before, such as praying for the safety of students and teachers when a school bus passes, or praying for those who are hungry when they're at the grocery store.
