

Marshmallow Message

Have you ever heard of the game “Chubby Bunny”? This is a fun way to try to memorize a Scripture verse or short passage, and have some family laughs!

Marshmallows – the big ones!, Paper, Marker



Prepare in Advance

Choose a Scripture verse or short passage that your family would like to memorize.

Activity Plan

1. Say this prayer aloud to begin.

God of Love, thank you for the time to be together as family. As we have fun with one another, may we also allow your Word to live in our hearts and this home. Amen.

2. How it works!
 - Write the chosen Scripture on the piece of paper.
 - Set the bag of marshmallows in a place where everyone can reach.
 - Everyone says the Scripture verse together without any marshmallows in their mouth.
 - Next, everyone puts one marshmallow in their mouth. Now, try to say the Scripture verse so everyone can understand.
 - Each round, everyone adds one more marshmallow, trying to recite the Scripture verse so your family can understand.
 - Continue until there is one person left! This person is the marshmallow message champion!
3. Take time at the end to discuss these questions:
 - What was the hardest part of this game?
 - Why is this verse important to your family?
 - Is it easy to remember a Bible verse?
 - Why is it important to have God’s word in our heart?
4. On the paper that has the Scripture verse on it add each person’s name and the number of marshmallows each could recite the verse with. Post the paper in a prominent place as a reminder of your marshmallow fun!
